

## **Guidance Alignment Overview**

Facilitation with site leaders and counselors focused on aligning schoolwide practices to an LCAP and research-based On Track Monitoring System of multiple indicators (including achievement, student engagement and school climate) correlated to student success. Guidance Alianment is a powerful collaborative process between student support services staff and teacher leaders from each department designed to monitor and come together five times per year to reflect on student progress on key On Track metrics for College and Career Readiness, by subgroup, including:



\*Advanced ELD counts for no more than one year of A-G requirements, per CSU-UC Freshman Admission Requirement, ELD completed in the Senior year will not count toward UC Admission requirements

- To monitor and ensure proper course placement
- To ensure A-G requirements are met
- To monitor student success
- To prevent dropout and provide students with a choice of college/career
- To tier students by similar profile, create an efficient group "treatment" and monitor progress in a collaborative manner
